7	12	<p>Developed statements identifying support <u>AND</u> challenge and extent of support. Final judgement needed on the overall extent of support.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Show how sources support each other by cross-referencing. • Show how sources challenge each other by cross-referencing. • Final judgement on the extent to which the sources support each other. 	12	<p>Developed explanation analysing two key features.</p> <p>An explanation analysing features supported by selected knowledge. Features include causes, events and consequences. Analyse two of these, support them with detailed knowledge and link them.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Analyse feature one. • Link and analyse feature two. • Short paragraph / sentence stressing the links between them.
15	27	<p>Sustained evaluation reviewing alternative views before giving a balanced judgement.</p> <p>Must use the sources to support both viewpoints and at least 3 sources in total - Use them <u>all</u> where possible!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Support the statement using the sources & own knowledge. • Challenge the statement using the sources & own knowledge. • Clear judgement comparing the relative importance of two or more factors. 	27	<p>A sustained analysis and judgment.</p> <p>The answer considers the inter-relationship between a range of aspects from the stimulus and additional material and makes a judgement on the process of change.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Analyse bullet point one & show how it brought change. • Analyse bullet point two & show how it brought change. • Analyse a point of your own & show how it brought change. • Judgement on overall extent of change &/or judgement on the most significant change.
